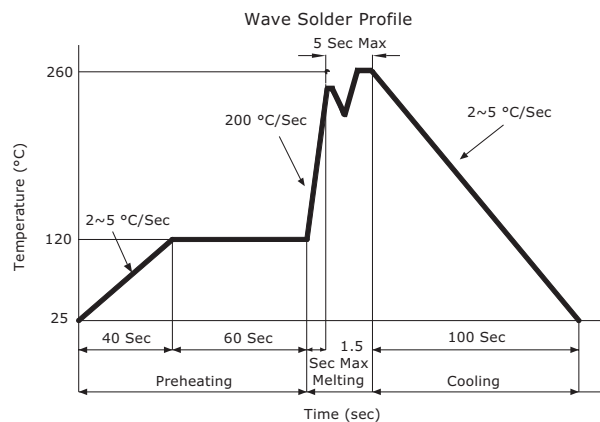

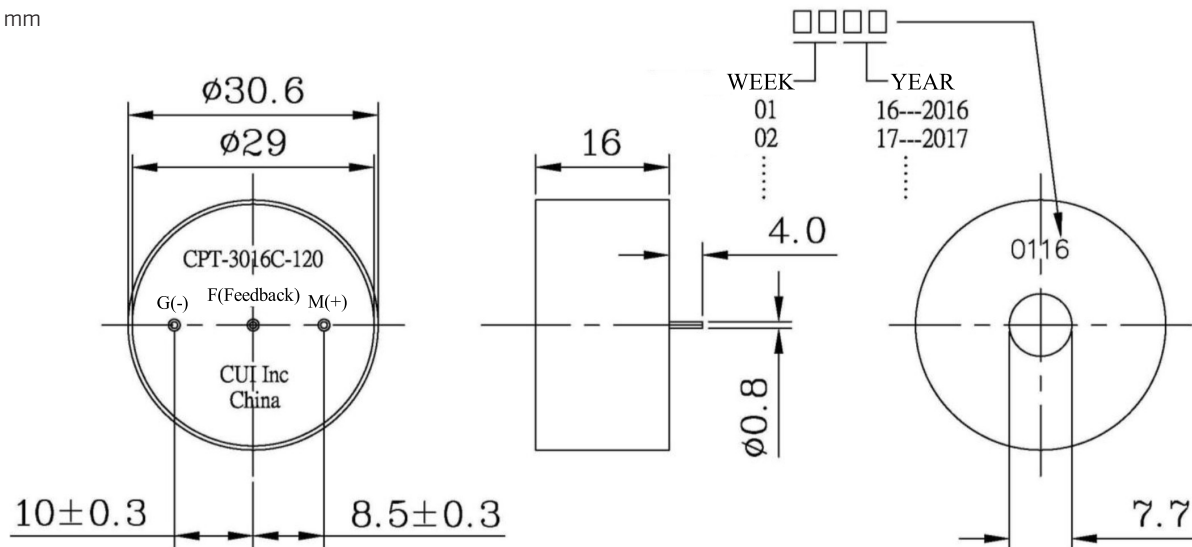

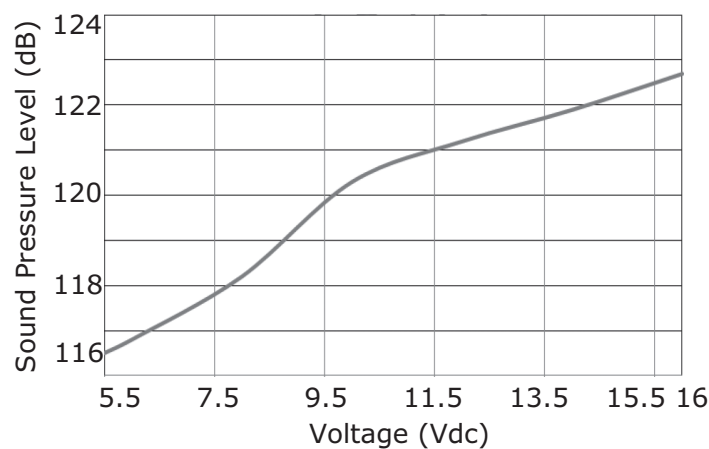

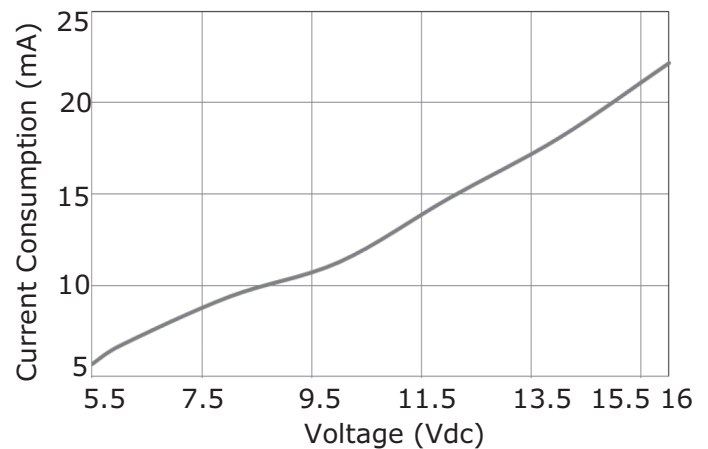


PERFORMANCE CURVES

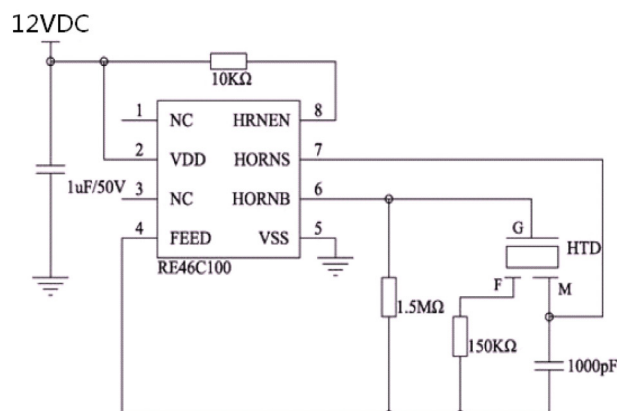
Voltage vs. Sound Pressure Level

DRIVING CIRCUIT

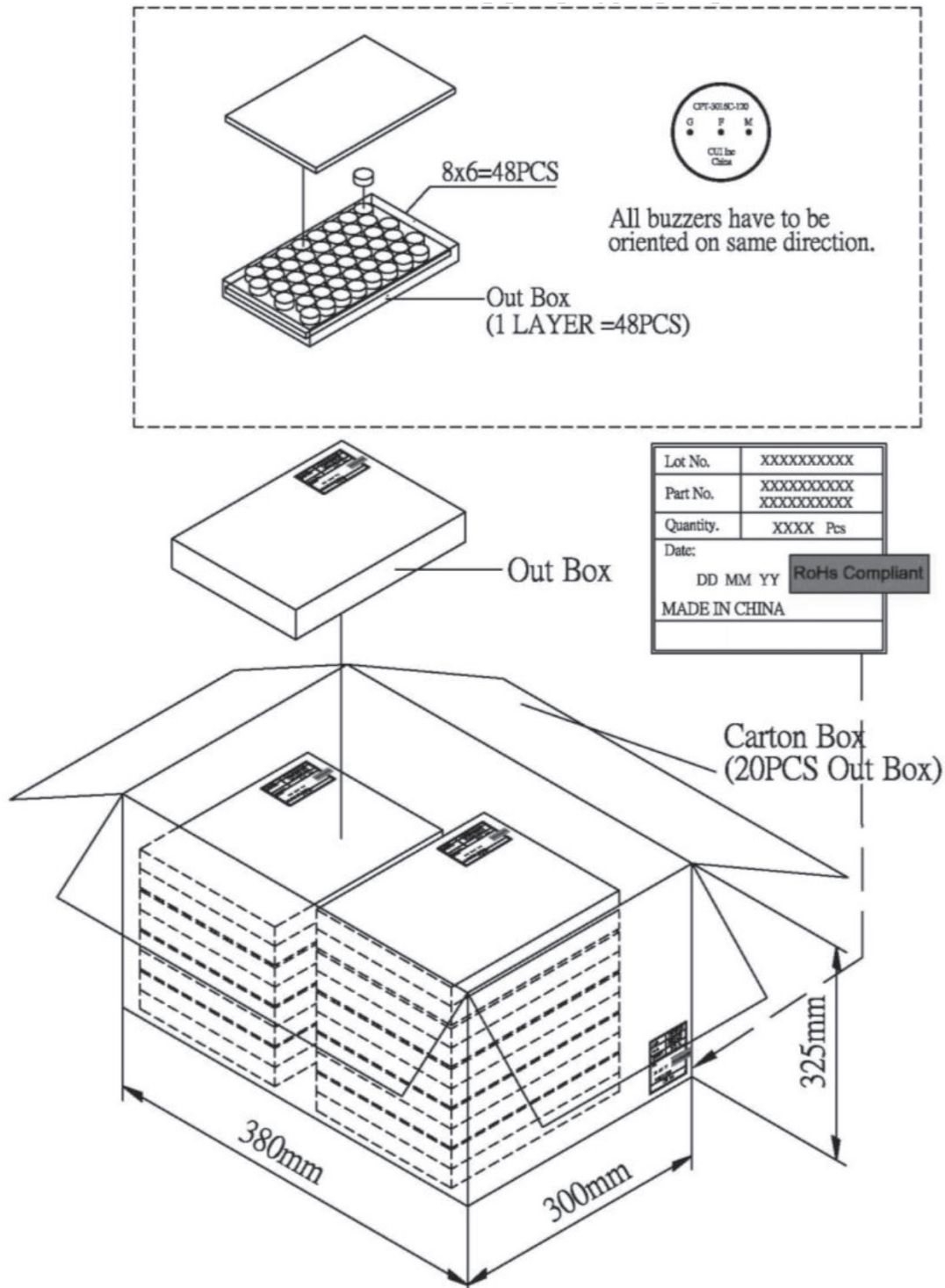


Notes: 1. The current consumption and the sound pressure level are measured by using the recommended driving circuit shown above.
